Declan, from Cheshunt, was the winner of Glastonbury Festival's *Emerging Talent Competition* in 2015, and will be dropping into Wormley between concert dates in Bristol and London



Declan said: "Seeing centres such as this neglected, under threat, and disappearing - as has happened locally at Wolsey Hall in my hometown of Cheshunt - is really saddening.

"What I want to see is the embracing of these local halls and venues for the community, which are run by and for local people

"That's why we're playing this show, to try and encourage more local people to get excited about what our local towns can be."

Support and Transition Routes into Volunteering and Employment

The STRIVE project is part of a county-wide initiative to boost skills for residents, and focuses on barriers to employment. The project provides dedicated one-to-one support from a local mentor which is tailored to individual interests and needs, helping participants move into sustainable employment, volunteering or education. Two mentors are now based in the hub on the first Wednesday of every month, and have already met with several local residents.
